


What's been happening at ATA?



INTERNSHIP TEACHER TRAINING PROGRAMME


The first cohort of the ITT programme has now come to an end with over fifty aspiring educators completing the professional development and school-based practicum across Aldar Education schools.

DEPTH OF RIGOR BESPOKE WORKSHOP

In January, the ATA team delivered 'Depth of Rigor' training to the staff at Al Danah Charter School. More than 100 members of staff attended the training which was delivered in English and Arabic. Participants in this workshop identified the concept of rigor and its importance in the classroom as well as exploring a variety of strategies that provide opportunities for challenge, stretch and support. Teachers were tasked with completing a follow up task to embed and evaluate various strategies.
